ASSESSMENT OF STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES August 2016

Columbia University School of Social Work Competency Benchmark

The Council on Social Work Education requires that all accredited schools of social work ensure that their students develop competency in 13 specific areas of professional practice. Each competency is further broken down into a set of related "advanced practice behaviors," established independently by each accredited school, which students in a given concentration are expected to master. Schools are required to assess their students' proficiency in the advanced practice behaviors and publicly report the percentage of advanced concentration students achieving a benchmark level of proficiency in each of the 13 competency areas. Each school is free to develop its own unique assessment methodology.

The faculty of CUSSW has set rigorous measurement benchmarks for the 13 competencies that comprise the accreditation standards of the Council. Each student is assessed on each of the advanced practice behaviors by academic and field instructors based on course and field internship assignments. Instructors provide ratings of each student's performance on each practice behavior. A student is determined to have "achieved benchmark" for a practice behavior if both their academic and field performance on that practice behavior was assessed as "Good — performance generally meets expectations for students at this level" or better (i.e., a score of 3 or higher). If a student meets the benchmark for all the practice behaviors for a given competency area, the student is said to have achieved the benchmark for the competency itself. Below, we report the percentage of students achieving our benchmark for each of the 13 areas of competency set by the Council.
