


2024 Master of Science in Social Work Degree Recipients Career Outcomes

Career outcomes were identified for 397 out of the 553 students who received the Master of Science in Social Work degree in 2024, yielding a knowledge rate of 72%.




The annual median salary for full-time employment in the US was \$70,000.¹ The average was \$71,825. Salaries ranged from \$30,000 to \$108,000, with an interquartile range of \$65,000 to \$78,500. Additional benefits/compensation mentioned by CSSW graduates included: professional development/education funds, medical (health, dental, vision) and life insurance, retirement contribution, student loan repayment, licensure expense reimbursement, and opportunities for additional compensation.

Employment Type






