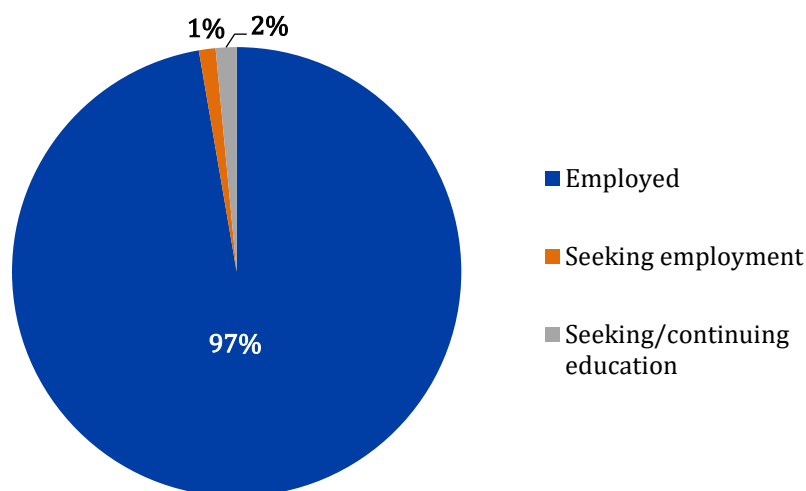


2025 Master of Science in Social Work Degree Recipients Career Outcomes

Career outcomes were identified for 406 out of the 622 students who received the Master of Science in Social Work degree in 2025, yielding a knowledge rate of 65%.

Primary Career Outcome



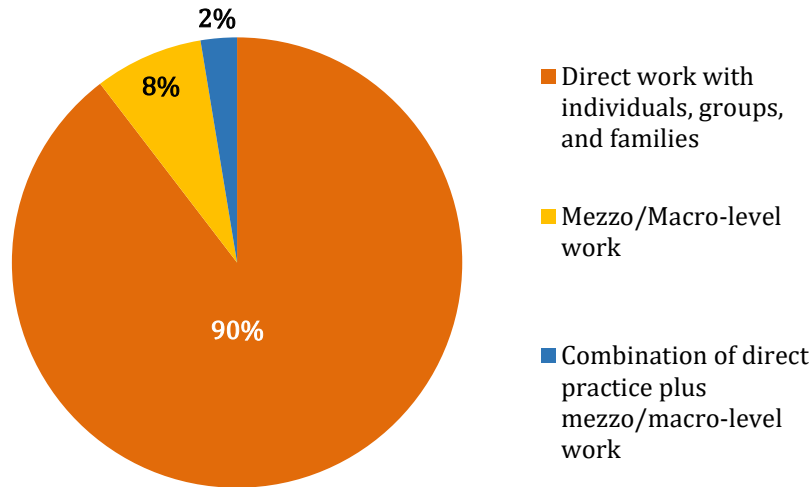

The annual median salary for full-time employment in the US was \$70,000.¹ The average was \$72,857. Salaries ranged from \$46,000 to \$110,000, with an interquartile range of \$63,500 to \$80,750. Additional benefits/compensation mentioned by CSSW graduates included: professional development/education funds, medical (health, dental, vision) and life insurance, retirement contribution, student loan repayment, licensing expense reimbursement, and opportunities for additional compensation.

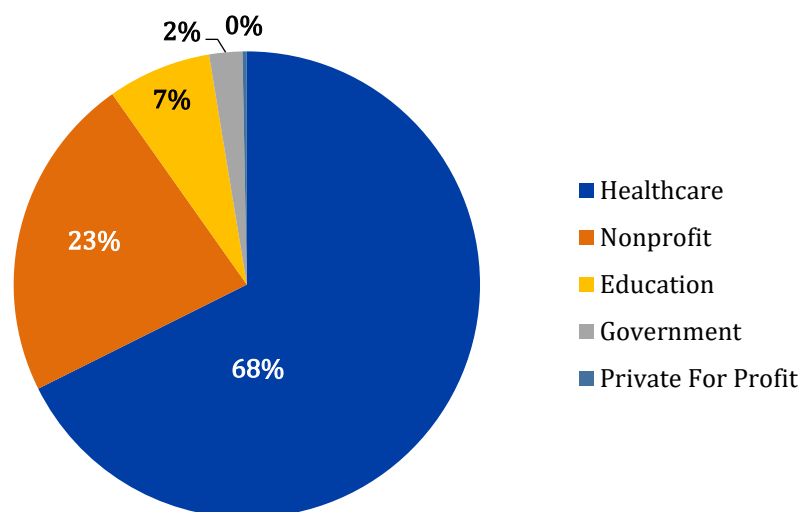

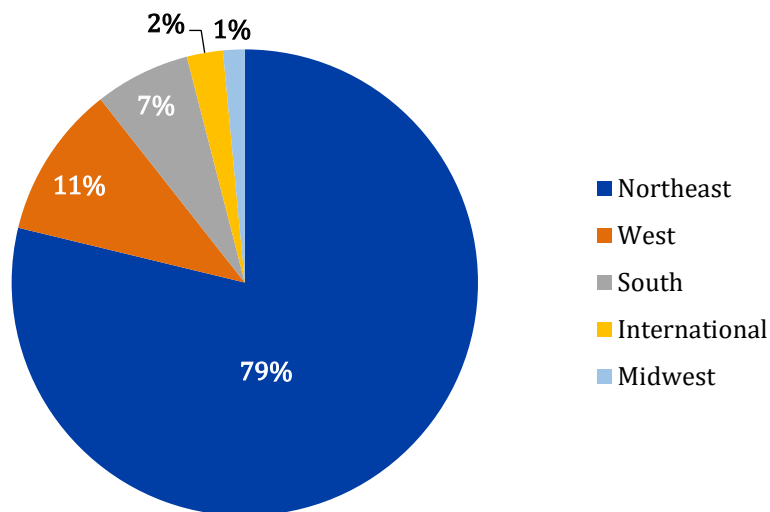

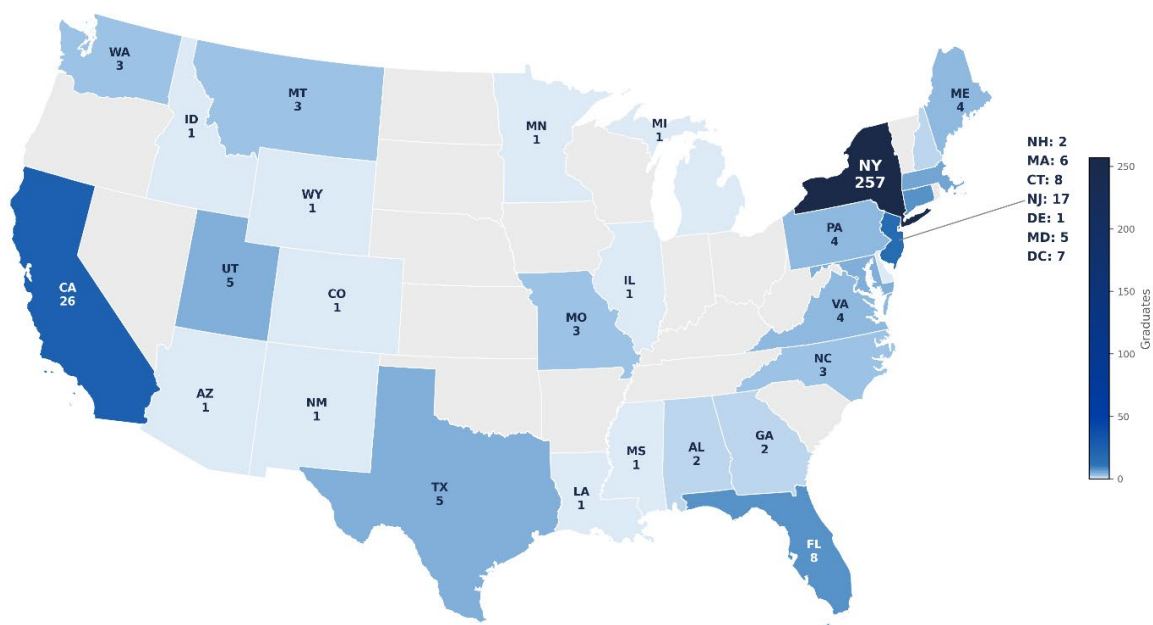
