

Career outcomes were identified for 370 out of the 565 students who received the Master of Science in Social Work degree in 2019, yielding a knowledge rate of 65%.




The overall average annual salary for full-time employment based on reported income was \$57,173. The overall median was \$56,000. Salaries ranged from \$37,000 to \$80,000, with an interquartile range of \$51,000 to \$64,000. Additional benefits/compensation mentioned included: professional development funds, retirement contribution, student loan repayment, signing bonuses, and relocation reimbursement.

### **Employment Type**






