Kajori currently serves as the Assistant Commissioner for the Community Relations Bureau at the NYC Commission on Human Rights. She oversees personnel management, community services, and bias response within her Bureau. She joined the Commission in 2016 as Director of the Bronx Community Service Center (CSC) after a decade in non-profit leadership and thoughtful management championing social justice and advocating for immigrant women's rights. Under her leadership, the Bronx CSC engaged newer immigrant and religious minority communities, bridged the gap between

historically under-served communities and government, and focused on strategic partnership and outreach. At the same time, she helped expand the bias response and inter-faith portfolios of the agency across the City. Kajori also served as the inaugural Director of the Social Work Unit within the Commission and expanded the scope of Social Work within a civil law enforcement agency.

In 2015, she was awarded NYC Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs' (MOIA) Fellowship for Immigrant Women Leaders as well as served as a member of MOIA's first Women's Advisory Cabinet. That year she also received the NASW-NYC Emerging Social Worker Leadership Award. She is a licensed Social Worker and a graduate of the Hunter College School of Social Work. She is a native speaker of Bengali and Hindi.
